Two plus years of supervisory experience required. Ability to work under pressure in a fast-paced team environment. Strong mechanical, electrical, hydraulic background and abilities. Experience with and be skilled in reading and interpreting electrical, mechanical, hydraulic and PLC ladder drawings. Strong problem solving and trouble shooting abilities. Excellent oral and written communication skills. Must be computer literate and familiar with appropriate software programs. Knowledge of Lean Manufacturing (Kanban, 5s, Std, Work, Problem Solving, etc.).
